



Dear ODAA Members & Affiliates:

The Board of Directors of the Oregon District Attorneys Association, Inc. (ODAA) invites you to register for the **ODAA 2016 Summer Conference scheduled for August 17th – 19th, 2016** at the **Riverhouse Hotel & Convention Center in Bend, Oregon**. Along with the always anticipated legislative and appellate updates, we have some very exciting presentations lined up with subjects including but not limited to:

- Butane Hash Oil Investigations (BHO)
- Victim's Rights Presentation & Panel Discussion
- Anti-Bias / Cultural Competency Presentation
- Media Communication Skills Workshop

Specific MCLE credit designations are pending and will be announced upon approval by the Oregon State Bar. Registration will be online this year (see the link below). There are several registration options. The details regarding these options are on the registration site as well as below. As official agendas and CLE information become available, they will automatically be sent to those who have registered.

Attendees are responsible for their own lodging (see DV exception below). There is a block of rooms at the government rate available at the Riverhouse Hotel & Convention Center (541) 389-3111. Just mention the ODAA Summer Conference when booking your room. The Shilo Inn and the Bend Inn & Suites are close by and also offer rooms at the government rate.

8/17 DUII Training:

This year, there will be **50 Lodging/Per Diem Scholarships available to prosecutors** (there is additional space for attendees but due to grant restrictions, we cannot reimburse everyone for lodging). These Scholarships will cover reimbursement for lodging at the government rate for the night of 8/16 and dinner per diem for the night of 8/17. Recipients will be chosen on a first come/first serve basis*. If you are chosen for a DUII scholarship, you will be notified via email by me before July 8th. **All attendees including scholarship recipients are responsible for making their own lodging arrangements.** I will provide you with instructions on how to receive reimbursement if you receive a scholarship. These scholarships do NOT cover mileage.

*We will make an attempt to ensure that all counties are represented at these trainings.

8/17 DV Training:

This year, there will be **40 Lodging Scholarships available** to prosecutors (there is additional space for attendees but due to grant restrictions, we cannot provide lodging for all attendees). In an effort to facilitate attendance by as many counties as possible, the first two attendees from a respective county will be awarded the lodging scholarship for that county. If there are lodging scholarships available after the initial registration process has been completed, additional attendees from already-attending counties may be granted surplus lodging. If you are chosen for a DV scholarship, you will be notified via email by me before July 8th. If you are awarded a lodging scholarship, **please do NOT make your own lodging arrangements:** A block of hotel rooms has already been reserved for this event. If you are

attending the rest of the ODAA Conference, you will need to make your own reservations for Wednesday and Thursday night. These scholarships do NOT cover per diem or mileage.

What registration option should I choose?

ODAA Member Conference Registration

Choose this option if you are:

1. An ODAA Member
2. You are attending the entire ODAA Conference (but **NOT** the DV or DUII training on 8/17) (this option will be typical for Elected DAs, Office Managers and DOJ employees)

ODAA Member Registration + 8/17 DOJ Domestic Violence Training

Choose this option if you are:

1. An ODAA Member
2. Attending the entire ODAA Conference **AND** the Domestic Violence Training on Wednesday, August 17th.

(This option will be typical for DDAs and other prosecutors)

8/17 DOJ Domestic Violence Training ONLY (Advocates/Prosecutors/Other)

Choose this option if you are:

1. **ONLY** attending the DOJ Domestic Violence training on Wednesday, August 17th.

ODAA Member Registration + 8/17 DUII Training

Choose this option if you are:

1. An ODAA Member
2. Attending the entire ODAA Conference **AND** the DUII training on Wednesday, August 17th.

(This option will be typical for DDAs and other prosecutors)

DVAP Registration

Choose this option if you are:

1. A Director/Employee of a Victims Assistance program
2. Attending the entire ODAA Conference

Non-ODAA Member Conference Registration

Choose this option if:

1. Your office does NOT pay dues to the ODAA
2. You will be attending the entire ODAA Conference (you will have the option to sign up for the DUII and DV trainings as well).

Speaker + Conference Attendee Registration:

Choose this option if:

1. You are speaking at the ODAA Conference

2. You will be attending the rest of the conference classes and events
